Midwifery Education Expert, in Dhulikhel/Nepal

Field of activity

Kathmandu University School of Medical Sciences (KUSMS) in Dhulikhel was selected to start the academic course, Bachelor of Midwifery. KUSMS has been started the Bachelor of Midwifery programme (4 years) for the first time in Nepal in August 2016.

To support the introduction of midwifery education, a Development Advisor (DA) has been requested to (1) teach midwifery students in classroom, clinical and community settings and (2) to build the capacity of Nepali midwifery faculty.

- As a midwifery education expert, the Development Advisor will support tutors and students in classroom, clinical settings.
- The DA will assist and conduct theoretical and clinical activities for midwifery students, as well as provide on-going support to midwifery tutors. Improving the quality of midwifery care at the clinical sites is another area that the DA will address. The DA will assist the quality implementation of the Bachelor of Midwifery education programme at Kathmandu University (KU) according to the set standards and curriculum of the Nepal Nursing Council and International Confederation of Midwives (ICM) standards

Your tasks - Assist the implementation of midwifery training and capacity building:

- Act as a midwifery education advisor and mentor to the faculty members of the Bachelor in Midwifery both in theoretical and clinical practice;
- Contribute to ensure the practice orientation/clinical guidance and supervision of the
 educational programme, e.g. mentoring faculty members in acquiring the necessary skills and
 modern teaching competency, conducting laboratory practice sessions and clinical instruction
 and their assessment to ensure the competency achieved by students;
- Advise in modern adult teaching methodology, e.g. assure participatory approach, role
 plays and exchange between students and promote practical exercises wherever possible.

Your profile - You offer the following qualifications:

- Midwife with Masters in Midwifery (or Bachelor in Midwifery with master's in health/education related subject)
- Significant clinical experience in Midwifery, including teaching and clinical supervision of students
- Advisory role to the faculty of Midwifery Education
- Skills in research methodology and analysis

- Proficiency level in English
- Good understanding and experiences of the development and intercultural context
- Regional Experiences are an asset
- Excellent communication skills
