We are looking for a qualified and motivated researcher to join the **Lausanne Perinatal Research Group**. Our current research program focuses on the impact of parental mental health during the perinatal period on child outcomes and, in particular, the intergenerational transmission of stress and trauma during the perinatal period. This includes physiological and EEG paradigms. In addition, we work on the development of early interventions to prevent the development of stress- and trauma-related mental health problems in parents and their infants. Our group works closely with clinical colleagues at the Lausanne and Geneva University Hospitals.
