

Author's contract

The German Society of Midwifery Science (DGHWi) will publish the proceedings of the 6th International Conference in paper form as a supplement to the DGHWi's Journal of Midwifery Science. In addition, the proceedings will be permanently stored and accessible online on the German Medical Science (GMS) platform.

In order to publish the contact details and abstract in German and/or English we require an author's contract.

§ 1 Subject matter of the contract

- 1. The subject of this contract is the work submitted by the author for publication.
- 2. The author confirms that s*he holds exclusive copyright to his*her work and that no prior legal concessions have been made which oppose the provisions of this contract. The same applies to the standard texts or master illustrations supplied by the author and whose rights of use s*he holds. If standard texts or master illustrations are offered to the DGHWi or German Medical Science for which this does not apply, or where it is uncertain if this applies, the DGHWi and German Medical Science must be informed of this and any recognisable legally relevant facts known to the author. If German Medical Science assigns the author with the procurement of other standard texts or master illustrations a special agreement is required.
- 3. The author is obliged to notify German Medical Science (service provider) in writing if the work includes interpretations from persons or incidents with which the risk of an infringement of personal rights is connected. S*he ensures immediate notification of the service provider in case of doubt or alleged or actual legal hindrances.
- 4. The rights holder exempts the service provider of any third-party claims.

§ 2

a: Rights for the online version (GMS)

- 1. The author transfers to German Medical Science the basic right of duplication and circulation of machine readable data media and their safeguard media.
- 2. The author transfers the rights to electronic storage in databases and web pages, in order to make available to the public for individual requests and display on the monitor to German Medical Science, with no restrictions as to time or location. This also comprises the right to notify and transfer the document to third parties, e. g. within the framework of national collection mandates, especially for the purpose of long-term archiving.
- 3. The author transfers to German Medical Science the right of translation into the English language.
- 4. The author transfers to German Medical Science the right to Print-on-Demand-Production.

- 5. The author transfers to German Medical Science the right to copy and convert the document for archiving purposes into additional, different electronic or physical formats. In such cases, damage to the content's integrity or the intellectual and personal rights of the author of the work is to be avoided.
- 6. German Medical Science grants online access rights to the author pertaining to his*her work stored in the database.

b: Rights for the print version

- In extension of Article 38 Section 1, Copyright Act (UrhG) of the German Society for Midwifery Science (DGHWi), the author transfers the exclusive, geographically and temporally unrestricted, right to store, duplicate, circulate and reproduce their work (including image, video and audio files). This includes translating and editing rights and is valid for the duration of the statutory copyright for all editions and publications in print and electronic form (e.g. online, offline, mobile use, embedded content).
- 2. The DGHWi has the right to fulfil and transfer the right of use of the complete work or parts thereof in print or electronic form.

§ 3 Contractual Obligation

- 1. The work will first appear exclusively in electronic form on GMS. Subsequent changes of the form of the first edition require the author's agreement.
- 2. German Medical Science is obligated to duplicate, circulate and adequately campaign for the work in the form specified in Section 1.

§ 4 Fee

1. The author does not receive a fee for his*her work. If the abstract is accepted the author is required to participate in the International Conference of the DGHWi and to pay the registration fee.

§ 5 Author Designation, Copyright Note

- 1. The DGHWi and German Medical Science are obligated to appropriately identify the author as originator of the work.
- 2. German Medical Science is obligated to attach the copyright note to the publication of the work in the sense of the Universal Copyright Convention.
- 3. The author agrees to German Medical Science publishing her work under a Creative Commons Attribution 4.0 International License (http://creativecommons.org/licenses/by/4.0/). This means that anyone can copy, redistribute and make the material/content publicly available, provided the original work/content is not edited or modified in any way and author and source are appropriately credited. See license information at http://creativecommons.org/licenses/by/4.0/. German Medical Science is obligated to attach a note about this license upon publication of the work.

§ 6 Final Clause

If not regulated by this contract, the general legal provisions of law of the Federal Republic of Germany apply. The invalidity or inefficacy of individual regulations of this contract does not affect the validity of the remaining regulations. The parties are then obligated to replace the deficient regulation by such a regulation whose economic and legal sense comes closest to that of the regulation to be replaced.
